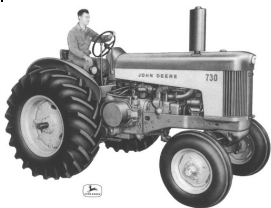

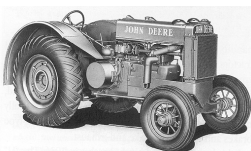

Gathering of the Green 2014

Sixteen members attended the March 19 to 25 classic John Deere event in Davenport, Iowa. Our group included Gary Friend, Ray Riggles, Paul Hieb, Dean Flaig, Les Faber, Marlen Knutson, Jim Sorensen, Dale Robertson, Don McKay, David Harrison and Alerd Johnson. Traveling separately were Mark. Michael Harrison, Jim and Cherie Alvshere and Albert Ulrich. As in past years, the group flew to O'Hare International airport in Chicago and took a van to Davenport, Iowa. This was one of those trips where you wake up at 3:30 am our time and check into the hotel at 6:30 pm Iowa time.

Unlike two years ago when the temperature was in the eighties, this year the weather was dry and temperatures ranging from the 20s to the high 40s

On Thursday, Friday and Saturday our group attended sessions on tractor repair and restoration. While not in a technical session the conference attendees could roam the vender area with over 60 booths offering new and used parts. Tours of John Deere factories, museums and significant antique Deere tractor and equipment collections were offered each day. A favorite dining spot is the Davenport Machine Shed where one of our members started a tradition of riding the Machine Shed replica hog. This year 35 states were represented with 39 registrants from Canada and one from England. Six collectors from Australia traveled the farthest. This was a record Gathering attendance year with over 2200 enthusiasts. On Saturday, several of the Washington group took a tour of the American Pickers Antique Archaeology museum at LeClaire, Iowa. We didn't see Mike Wolfe or Frank Fritz but we did experience some of their special "picks" from across the United

States. Daniele wasn't there either.

On Sunday, our group was provided a special tour of the Gary and Judy Bocker "Barnacopia museum near Polo, Illinois. This new three story "kit" barn was prefabricated in Connecticut and moved to Polo on six trucks. The barn was assembled on site taking a year and a half to complete ready for their grandson's June 1, 2011 wedding reception. The museum barn contains Gary's collection of classic cars and agriculture equipment (lots of Deeres). One thing lead to another and the barn interior developed into themes. The ground floor includes a 1950's diner and ice cream parlor. On the different barn floors you will find a game room, chapel, store fronts, library and a one room school. Cars and trucks displayed though out the barn. A Ford tractor is displayed under the glass entry floor and a John Deere suspended at the top of the third story. An addition to the barn was a five story high concrete silo with spiral staircase. Judy Bocker designed well decorated bedrooms with baths for over night stays. This would be a play on the "night at the museum" theme with bed and breakfast. The Bocker's now have opened Barnacopia for weddings, receptions, birthdays, anniversaries and meeting events.

On Monday our group took a guided tour of the Peoria, Illinois Caterpillar tractor assembly plant where D6 though D-11 Cats were manufactured. The early afternoon was spent at the Caterpillar visitor center displaying Cat products new and old. The Cat mining truck with 13 foot tall

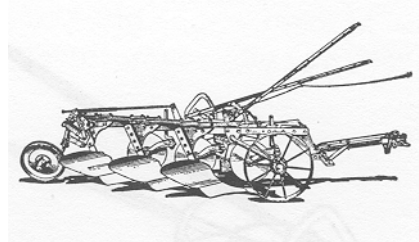

The March/April edition of the Two Cylinder magazine announced that the National Two-Cylinder EXPOs will end with the 2015 exhibit. The EXPOs started in 1987 and will end with the 25th exhibition. The reasons stated was the cost of fuel to transport tractors and the opening of the Waterloo John Deere Tractor and Engine Museum near the current Waterloo Cattle Congress EXPO show grounds. The new

John Deere Museum will be open year around and will also feature tractor and engine displays. If you always wanted to attend an EXPO you better start making plans. This year's event is scheduled for June 19,20 and 21. If you want to exhibit your tractor you must go through an approval process.

On April 5, eighteen club members attended a tour of fourteen log cabins restored at the Ferndale Pioneer Park. The cabins were originally located at different areas of Whatcom county and moved to the park for preservation. This is considered the world's largest collection of cedar slab log cabins. The Church is the oldest structure dating back to 1876 and the newest is the Pioneer Park headquarters built on site in 1926. All cabins are listed on the Washington State Historical register. A big thank you to Don McKay and Loren Dahl for organizing this shop tour.

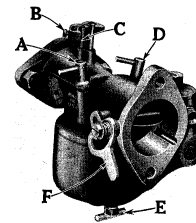

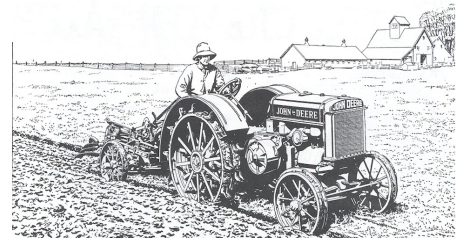
