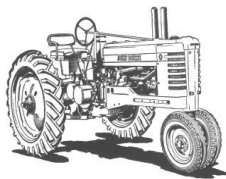

## Jerry Rindal, Long Time John Deere Dealership Owner

Jerry Rindal got his first taste of John Deeres working for a farmer on Fir Island. Jim Solseth farmed with a John Deere AR and 15 year old Jerry got early driving experience plowing with the AR and a three bottom plow. Jerry joined the U.S. Army in 1953 and after being discharged in 1955 went to work for Barnett Implement. Ernie Barnett had Jerry start out as a "grease monkey" cleaning things and delivering stuff around the shop. Eventually Jerry worked into a mechanic position and eventually into sales. In 1966 Jerry and Darwin Geerdes had the opportunity to buy 50% of the business from Ernie Barnett and in 1970 Jerry and Darwin became 100% owners in the dealership. In the early 1950s Barnett Implement was located on Riverside Drive near the current Outlet Foods store but in 1972 the dealership was moved to the current location in south Mount Vernon. That dealership has now grown to 6 acres. Barnett Implement continued to grow with additional stores in Snohomish, Yakima, Sumner and Chehalis. Currently Jerry's holdings include Mount Vernon, Snohomish and the Yakima dealership. While the Snohomish store focuses on compact tractors and lawn equipment, the Mount Vernon business sells a lot of the big tractors and equip-

ment to the Skagit Valley potato farmers. Deere rules in Skagit county! Jerry says the large Deeres are split between purchase and the rental/ lease agreements. The rentals may vary from two months to a season lease to annual leases. Jerry doesn't see any near change in Skagit agriculture as long as the specialty potatoes are in demand. Yes, they do sell a lot of compact tractors and lawn mowers.

Bill Rindal is Jerry's son and current president and manager of the Mount Vernon store. Jerry is also very proud of his three grandsons and one grand daughter who work in the Snohomish and Mount Vernon dealerships.

Currently, Jerry's Deere collection includes 20 two cylinder Deere's and four new generation tractors. The collection contains mostly tractors used in the local Skagit valley area. The letter series include the model A, B, G, H, L, LA, M, D, and two Rs. Also included in the two cylinders series are a model 60, 320, 520, 720, 730, 820 and 830. The 320 U is most likely the most rare. The new generation collection includes a 1010U, 3010, 4010, and 5020. Most of the tractors were restored by Mike Hereford during the slower time of the year. Jerry says that since Mike retired he doesn't think he will restore any more after the current 1941 G is complete.

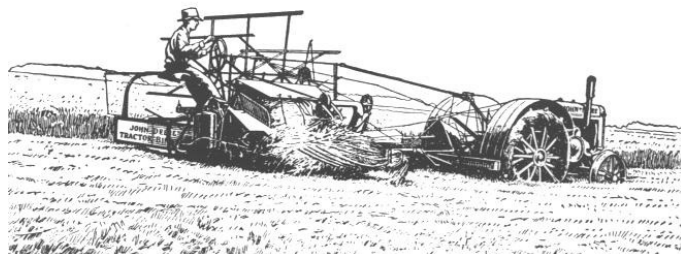

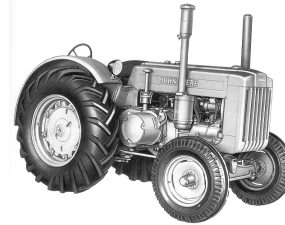
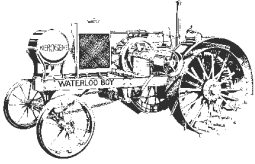
